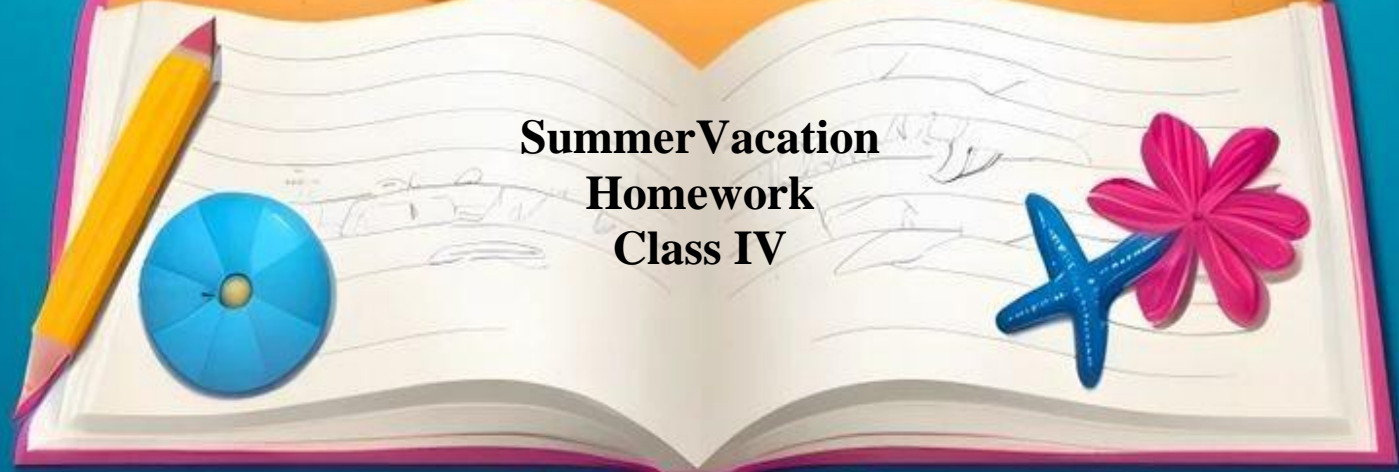

1. Diversity Scrapbook:

- Page 4: One country, one feeling (short paragraph- 5 lines)

Note: Each page must have pictures (drawn or pasted), 4-5 lines in English.

2. Draw the Indian map and write: "Unity in Diversity" in the center and decorate with symbols of different states.

3. Holiday Experience Task: Meeting different people.

Title: "People I met during my summer holidays."

Students have to write 8-10 sentences about any one of the following:

- A place they visited.

- People from a different culture they met in their locality.
